My name is Katie McTyre and I am so excited to be back at Egremont for my 6th year as the music teacher! It is so important to me that music is a creative outlet and a welcoming and fun space for everyone. Recognizing that every student will have different loves and strengths, my goal is to cover a wide variety of topics and activities in each class to engage every student. Yes, we will be singing, and covering basic musical concepts and musical notation. In addition to that, we will be continuing our use of the fabulous musical interactive program QuaverEd, and each grade level will be studying classical composers and eras, famous pieces of music, instruments of the orchestra, and creating their own class compositions!

Each class has access to our instruments throughout the year including: boomwahckers, bucket drums, rhythm sticks, shakers, hand bells, and hand drums. Our 2nd & 3rd Graders will be starting with recorders (outside and distanced) and our 5th Grade will be starting violin soon. New for this year, 4th Grade will be starting ukulele! Instruments use agreements forms for 4th and 5th Grade will be going out this week for students and parents to sign regarding care of their instruments. Please keep instruments in or around school supplies so students have them every week for class. Instrument schedules are as follows:

• 2nd Grade Recorder: Wednesdays

• 3rd Grade Recorder: Tuesdays

4th Grade: Tuesdays & Wednesdays5th Grade: Wednesdays & Thursdays

Student grades in music are based off of participation. While I do know that everyone's skills and interests will be varied, I do expect good behavior and effort in class and will be making grades based off of this. Students will have class work and worksheets throughout the school year that will be graded and count towards their overall participation. While worksheets are graded, they are mostly used as a gauge for me regarding class comprehension.
